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10th Annual General Meeting on 26 June 2021

The President Report

1. The Council

The year of 2020/2021 is a busy and challenging year for healthcare professionals, especially our fellow nurses who have been fighting tediously and timelessly against COVID-19. However, the COVID-19 pandemic has not abated Hong Kong Academy of Nursing (HKAN) from speeding up the development of advanced nursing practice in Hong Kong. The HKAN continuously plays a crucial role in supporting nurses who practise in different capacities of their specialty areas to serve the people in Hong Kong with high standards.

1.1. Academy Colleges and Membership

As of 31st May 2021, there are active registration of 2364 Fellow Memberships and 32 Ordinary Memberships.

The HKAN welcomes a total of 22 earned Ordinary Members in 2020/2021 and 26 earned Fellow Members who passed the Fellowship Exit Assessment as stipulated by the Academy Colleges. With great honor, Ms. WONG Yuet Ngor Anne Marie, Prof. Anecita P. FADOL and Prof. Rebecca JESTER are being nominated and to be conferred as Honorary Fellows in 2021. Unfortunately, the 9th & 10th Conferment Ceremony have been postponed due to COVID-19 pandemic.

2. Committee Reports

2.1. Accreditation Committee

The Manual for College Accreditation was reviewed and revised according to the new pathway. It was uploaded in the HKAN website. Manuals from . Colleges for accreditation also have been revised and were submitted for vetting on 17th March 2021. All Colleges have completed the re-accreditation exercise with college validity and program validity aligned in the same year.

2.2. Education Committee

The Academy has re-structured the pathway for progression to her Fellowship, with rationales as follows: (a) enhancing education commitment for Ordinary Members; and (b) adopting the philosophy of inclusion in which heterogeneity is desirable and nurses from

diverse backgrounds are valued with equal learning opportunities. This will enable the Academy to better serve and benefit the community as pledged. The new pathway has already taken effect from May 2021. With this new pathway, the Academy would be able to build up a strong specialized nursing workforce for providing quality advanced nursing care to local populations that they serve.

The Manual for Program Planning and Examination was revised according to the new pathway. It was uploaded to HKAN website. Manuals from Colleges for Program Planning and Examination have been revised and submitted for vetting on 17th March 2021. Hong Kong College of Gerontology Nursing has her membership program submitted, assessed and granted validation till 2023. All colleges have completed the membership program re-accreditation exercise with college validity and program validity aligned in the same year.

An Ordinary Admission Interview has been added into the new pathway and the guideline of admission interview has been developed and disseminated to Colleges.

2.3. Registration and Membership Committee

There are 2364 Fellow Members and 32 Ordinary Members renewed as at 31st May 2021. HKAN welcomed the admission of 22 Ordinary Members from 4 Academy Colleges and 26 Fellow Members from 8 Academy Colleges in 2020/2021. With the launching of the new pathway of membership and fellowship in specialty nursing from May 2021 and the promotion by colleges, the application of membership is greatly increased.

2.4. Promotion & Public Relations Committee

HKAN has launched a series of promotional activities since October 2020 with a view to promote advanced nursing practice and to provide up-to-date health knowledge through the media. Health articles (護專世代) are published on the Hong Kong Economic Journal twice a month and short videos on specialty nursing under the topic of (“專科護理 3 分鐘 “) are produced and posted on social media platforms once a month. Moreover, Academy College representatives are interviewed by RTHK “Healthpedia”(精靈一點) to share on health related topics every second Tuesday of the month. The touching nursing stories and inspiring experiences shared by fellow members in these channels are well commented.

2.5. Fund Raising Committee

No fund raising activities has been conducted due to COVID-19 pandemic.

2.6. Professional Development Committee

- On-line Learning Platform was developed to provide and to facilitate the Academy of CNE activities for members achieving CNE points. Six learning articles have been uploaded.
- HKAN sponsored two quotas to attend the virtual 11th NP/APN Conference which will

be held at Halifax, Canada.

- HKAN had co-organized the 15th International virtual Symposium on Healthy Ageing with the Research Centre of Heart, Brain, Hormone and Healthy Aging, Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine, The University of Hong Kong, on 13-14 March 2021.

2.7. Executive Committee

The Executive Committee was chaired by the President, members being the office bearers of the Academy Council, namely the Vice Presidents, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer. The main purpose of the Committee is to deliberate strategic directions and resolve operational issues before and after Council meetings. Six meetings were held since last AGM 2021. Executive Committee members have regular meetings with Advisors, leaders and top management from the Food and Health Bureau, Hospital Authority, Nursing Council of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and the Advisors of HKAN to update the progress of the HKAN and to share the forthcoming directions on nursing professional.

3. Special Project Reports

3.1. Nursing Council of Hong Kong (NCHK) on Advanced/Specialized Nursing Subgroup

As invited by Nursing Council, Hong Kong (NCHK) in joining the Voluntary Scheme on Advanced and Specialized Nursing Practice workgroup, HKAN's contributions in core-competency developments of specialties are well recognized. A total of 16 specialties core-competency have been completed and submitted to NCHK.

3.2. Universal Community Testing Program (UCTP)

HKAN was invited by the Government to operate 3 Community Testing Centers at Sham Shui Po Center, Tuen Mun Tai Hing Center and Tuen Mun Leung Tin Center in Sept 2020. HKAN was assigned by Civil Service Branch to support the central relieving pool.

3.3. Community Vaccination Centers (CVC)

HKAN was selected to operate two Community Vaccination Centers (CVC) of the Government COVID-19 Vaccination programme at Tung Chung and Hong Kong International Airport. The vaccination service started on 16 March 2021. Running these 2 centers is a big challenge to Academy, but with the support by our physician partners and our nurses, a lot of difficulties have been overcome and the mission is in progress.

By request of the Food and Health Bureau, Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) and HKAN were the co-organizers to produce an online training video for the COVID_19 vaccination Programme which is mandatory for the medical teams serving the vaccination centres.

3.4. 1st International Advanced Practice Nursing Conference 2021 (IAPNC2021)

The 1st International Advanced Practice Nursing Conference 2021 (IAPNC2021) in hybrid was successfully held on 22-23 May 2021 with 1085 attendees from local and overseas. The Conference, funded by the Professional Services Advancement Support Scheme (PASS), was organized by the HKAN, in collaboration with Hospital Authority, Department of health, Chinese University of Hong Kong, University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Open University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, Tung Wah College and Caritas Institute of Higher Education. The theme of the conference is “Catalyst for A Brighter Future in Health”. 7 keynote speakers and 10 plenary speakers from local and overseas were invited to share their excellent work in advanced practice nursing and the experience in combating COVID-19.

3.5. Training Course for District Health Centre (DHC) Nurse

The HKAN, in collaboration with Hong Kong College of Community & Public Health Nursing (HKCCPHN) conducted the following two course for nurses who are interested in providing community-based primary health care:

- Post-registration Certificate Course District Health Center Module 2020: 10 October 2020 to 6 February 2021. With a total of 50 participants competed the training.
- Post-registration Certificate Course District Health Center Module 2021: 10 April 2021 to 31 July 2021. With a total of 42 participants.

The next training course was proposed to be conducted at 4Q2021. The FHB has provided sponsorship of an amount of HK\$3,000 for the participants who have successfully completed the course.
